I beg to confirm my telegram of 4th. instant regarding the S.S. "DANUBIAN" Hull and Machinery Classification certificates.

This cable was sent at the Owner's request who pointed out that the matter was quite urgent. In view of the Owner's repeated enquiries from the date of the cablegram, and my inability to give him a satisfactory reply, I was preparing to write to you on the subject, when I was surprised to learn from Mr. James Macdonald, the ex B.C. Surveyor at this Port, that he had received them this last day or so, the Classification Certificates and had forwarded them to the Owner.

Mr. Macdonald's appointment having been terminated some time ago, I therefore presume that this incident is due to some clerical error.

I feel I should draw your special attention to this matter, as you will realize that I have been placed in a most embarrassing situation, and any repetition of this occurrence, is likely to create considerable confusion with B.C. owners at this Port.
