This ship was built in July 1898 by Messrs. Ropner & Sons, Stockton, to class +100A1 with freeboard with Lloyd's Register of Shipping, this class being withdrawn in 1943 for non-compliance. The present Owners, the Near East Shipping Company, Panama, (Managers - Cyprus Shipping Co. Ltd.) submitted the ship for classification by the British Corporation in June 1948.

A Special Survey on the hull and machinery, including drydocking, drillings, repairs, boilers, main steampipes, tailshaft and annual load line surveys has been carried out by the non-exclusive Surveyors to the British Corporation at Alexandria from June 23rd until December 10th 1948.

On completion of the Surveys the Surveyors reported that the ship was in good and seaworthy condition and recommended classification. A confirmatory survey has been carried out (13-6-49) at Alexandria by the exclusive Surveyor to Lloyd's Register, who states that the general condition is good.

The scantlings and structural arrangements have been examined and found satisfactory.

In view of the age of this ship the reports, including the drillings, have been most carefully examined. The B.C. non-exclusive Surveyor who carried out the Survey has always been reliable; he is a Surveyor of wide experience and the report of L.R.'s exclusive Surveyor on the confirmatory Survey supports the recommendation for class. The Owners have carried out all the recommendations made by the Surveyors.

IT IS SUBMITTED that the ship be classed BS and machinery MBS.
