E. I was favoured with your letter of the 13th instant forwarding a plan of shafting proposed for your Engines Nos. 2640-1 intended for Messrs. Cochrane & Son's Yard Nos. 1079 & 1080, and with regard thereto I have the pleasure to acquaint you that with steam reciprocating engines for ocean going service having cylinders 9", 15" and 24" dia. by 18" stroke, working pressure 190 lb. per square inch, diameter of propeller 5'6", screw shaft without continuous liner, the proposed sizes of shafting, viz:- crank 4.15/16", thrust 4.15/16", intermediate 4.11/16" and screw shaft 5.5/16" diameter, will be approved.

The plan is being retained for the guidance of the local Surveyors.
