Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in 1943-5

Two steel companions have been fitted on upper deck aft each 6'-6" high 5'-3" long 3'-6" wide with hinged wooden doors 1 1/2" thick running from either side. Sills 2 1/2" high.

Additional ventilators have been fitted as follows:-

Upper deck aft.	3 @ 12" dia	36" high	.34 thick.
"	1 @ 9" "	36" "	.32 "
"	11 @ 6" "	36" "	.30 "

The ventilators are closed by wooden plugs & canvas covers.

One 8" dia ventilator on upper deck aft has been removed.

In after keelson deck additional discharges overboard have been fitted 3 @ 4" dia, 1 @ 2" dia, each fitted with storm valve at shell and control rod to upper deck.
