and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all ^{temporary} repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that she be continued as classed in the Register Book, with record of drydocking survey 8,54, subject to indented bottom shell plating and internals in way of No.5 & 6 D.B. Tanks and shell plating and internals in way of No.1 & 2 hold (Port side) being dealt with before the end of December, 1954, also as previously recommended

being fit to carry her usual cargoes.
