Mr. Sheffield, of Metcalf Motor Coasters, Ltd. attend at Messrs. Union Dry Dock & Engineering Co., Ltd. on 5th September, 1950, and subsequently, for the purpose of examining a centrifugal pump and driving engine stated ex S/T "SALVAGE".

The Unit is by Messrs. Drysdale & Co., Ltd.

The engine was examined in its entirety and found in good condition. The cylinders were not tested at this time but a pressure test stamp was evident, viz: 190 lb./sq.in.

The pump was examined in its entirety, the casing tested by hydraulic pressure to 50 lb./sq.in. and all found satisfactory.

For identification purposes, the unit is stamped on the front column of the engine, No. 5934, and on the pump flange LLOYD'S TEST 50 lb./sq.in. D 9.9.50.

It is stated that this unit is being despatched to Messrs. Lamont & Co., Ltd. Port Glasgow, with a view to its being installed in the s/s "FREDERICK HATCH" now under repair.
