S. I have to acquaint you that the case of the Steamer "FREEMAN HATCH" has now received consideration in connection with the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle-on-Tyne in March last.

As a result of this inspection the vessel has been classed "100A1" and Classification certificates in respect of the Special Survey of hull and machinery are accordingly enclosed, from which you will observe that the machinery classification is subject to pumping arrangements being brought up to Rule requirements.

In view of the Screwshaft Survey carried out in April 1947 by the British Corporation a further Screwshaft Survey does not become due until April 1950.
