I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 13th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

These cases received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, and instructions were given for notations to be recorded in the Society's Register Book indicating that the class of each ship had been withdrawn at the Owners' request.

In the case of the "BANGO", however, the notation "Class suspended - Surveys overdue 10,56" already appeared against the ship's name in the Register Book, and having regard to the fact that the Society's requirements as regards periodical surveys have not been complied with, instructions were given for a notation to be recorded in the Register Book against this ship indicating that the class has been expunged on account of non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
