I duly received your letter of the 13th June regarding alterations proposed to be carried out to enable this ship to operate as a coastal freighter and have to state that provided plans of the alterations be submitted for approval the repairs and alterations be carried out to your satisfaction then on receipt of a satisfactory report the ship could be recommended for a coastal service the limits of which will have to be defined.

If the hatch coamings are increased to Rule height and the Load Line Rules in other respects complied with, consideration will be given to a reduction of freeboard, the amount being dependent upon the limits of service proposed in view of the design characteristics of this ship.
