I would refer to my letter of yesterday's date having reference to the proposal to class with this Society TWO (2) Oil Tankers to be built by Messrs. Davie Shipbuilding & Repairing Co. Limited, Lauzon, P.Q.

This letter will confirm that these Vessels would be surveyed during construction with a view to their being classed * 100 A1 'Carrying Petroleum in Bulk' etc. (i.e. with the Maltese Cross); that the inclusive fee per ship would be \$11,000.00 plus travelling expenses; the structural Plans for the vessels would be approved on the same basis as for similar vessels building at the Bethlehem Steel Co's Shipyards at Quincy and Sparrows Point, U.S.A., the Plans for which have already been approved by our New York Office.

The fee quoted above would include the survey of Hull, Machinery and all testing of materials, as per my letter of yesterday's date.
