Thank you for your letter of the 26th instant,
respecting the Tanker "ANDROS VENTURE", the contents of which
are noted.

Mr. Riddell is at present on holiday but I think
it well to advise you that as detailed in Montreal First Entry
Reports No. 9906, subsequent to the river trials the bearings
and journals of the main turbines, the main gearing, journals and
bearings and the two generating sets with their gearing were
opened up and examined by the Surveyors at Quebec.

This examination could in no way be considered a
normal procedure after a trial trip but was effected on Mr. Riddell's
specific instructions in an endeavour to justify the Maltese Cross
for the machinery.

We accordingly await the receipt of a further
communication from you and should Mr. Riddell have any further
comments to offer upon his return these will be forwarded to you
immediately.
