Dear Sir,

Steamer "ANDROS VENTURE"

Before your Report No. 9906 receives the consideration of the Committee, I shall be glad if you will forward plans for approval as required by Paragraph E.401 of the Rules or alternatively, if these plans have been previously approved for a sister ship, the name and yard number of the vessel should be stated.

I shall be glad to learn if the generators and motors over 100 KW have been built under survey and if certificates of test for generators and motors under 100 KW have been supplied and the results found as per Rule, as this information has been omitted from the First Entry Report.

I shall be glad if you will state the heating surface of the boiler superheaters, as the total heating surface of the boilers as quoted in your report does not include the superheater heating surface.

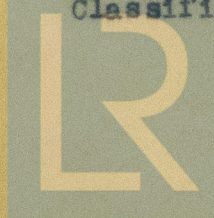
Copies of the "As Built" plans of Midship Section and Profile and Decks should be furnished, although stated to have been forwarded do not appear to have been received in this Office.

I shall be glad if you will state whether any steel in accordance with Chapter P, Paragraph 403 of the Rules has been used in the construction of this tanker, and if so particulars should be forwarded in accordance with Circular No. 1965 (Paragraph 3).
