"ARES III"

The case of the above ship has today received the consideration of the Committee in the light of your letters of the 29th September and 6th instant, and they have noted that the Owners now propose transferring the class of this ship to the American Bureau.

The position so far as they see it is that as a special dispensation to the previous Owners they agreed to the repairs carried out at the last Special Survey in April 1965 being limited to those required to maintain the vessel in service only until the end of last month. This means to say that there were many repairs still outstanding which normally would have been required to receive attention at the Special Survey.

As the validity of the Modified Special Survey notation has now expired and the Society's Surveyors have not been called to verify that the outstanding repairs have been satisfactorily dealt with, the Committee considered that they had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book on account of reported defects.
