We beg leave to refer to our Falmouth Report No. 14896, previously forwarded, and have to advise you that Messrs. Houlder Bros. state the sale of this ship has now been completed and been handed over to her new Owners, Messrs. Marguardia Compania Naveira S.A., of Panama. The new and amended particulars are as follow:-

New Name:	"ARES III".

Port of Registration:	Chios.

We understand that it is the intention of the new Owners to transfer the ship's Class to the American Bureau of Shipping, completing the necessary surveys at Bombay, to which port she is proceeding, via U.S.A./Canadian ports, with a cargo of grain.

We further understand that, subject to the A.B.S. accepting the ship for Classification at Bombay, it is the intention of the new Owners to let her L.R. Classification lapse. We would report that there was some difficulty in obtaining this information but we believe that it is substantially correct.
