Motorship "ATRAX".

I have today read to the Committee your letter of the 13th instant, but they have asked me to point out that their decision conveyed to you on the 2nd instant was based entirely upon the classification position as seen by them, viz not only had the year of grace expired, but also the additional extension until the end of June which they had previously granted, and although it was made quite clear in our letter of 21st July that the Committee would be unable to continue the ship in class unless a satisfactory proposal was received for the overdue Special Survey to be dealt with immediately on the vessel's arrival at a Continental port, the vessel was not submitted to the Society's Antwerp Surveyors for inspection on arrival.

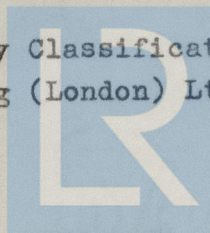
The fact that they did not have before them the Owners' letter of the 15th August requesting withdrawal of class, in no way affected their final decision to which, with regret, they have today adhered.
