With reference to my letter of the 24th May and to the telephone conversation which took place today, I have to point out that the year of grace for the Special Survey expired so long ago as the end of March last, and that although the Committee have agreed to maintain classification until some time before the end of June 1966, they may well decide that they have no alternative but to deal with the vessel's class unless all Rule requirements are in hand by that date.

I shall be glad if you will advise the Owners accordingly and let me know, for the early information of the Committee, what arrangements are made for the muchoverdue Special Survey to be held by the end of the present month.

I would remind you that a Steampipes Survey will be required at the Special Survey when the Donkey Boiler Survey, due at the end of March last, should also be held and the outstanding conditions of class be dealt with.
