


# LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

and that ~~I~~<sup>we</sup> have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all repairs recommended by ~~me~~<sup>us</sup> have been completed to ~~my~~<sup>our</sup> satisfaction, and that ~~I~~<sup>we</sup> have Recommended that she be eligible to remain as now classed and to have record of docking 9,57, subject to all conditions at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously recommended and to bottom plate of rudder being specially examined next docking, being fit to carry petroleum in bulk
