Dear Sir,

You are aware from the several letters and cablegrams we have sent to you on the subject that your failure to attend to our correspondence and to furnish us with returns and reports as necessary has caused unwarranted inconvenience. The situation has not improved and is rapidly becoming intolerable.


Your letter to us of the 20th March 1956 was the belated sequel to a series of letters we had sent to you and although it at least attempted some explanation of your difficulties and promised an improvement in your conduct of our affairs it did not satisfy the specific enquiries we had made of you into the case of the "STANVAC VISAYAS II", neither did you furnish the outstanding returns to which our previous enquiries related.

We were obliged to make further enquiry of you on this and other points on the 1st May 1956 but again we failed to secure the courtesy of acknowledgement or reply.

Our cablegram of the 10th October referred to the inconvenience caused to the Owners of the "INGER SKOU", the Salvage Association, the Corporation of Lloyd's and ourselves because you had not furnished your report on the survey of this ship.

You have also ignored our letter of the 1st October, 1956, to which we asked for a reply by return in respect of the new tonnage in the Philippines.

We can no longer submit to a situation of this kind and indeed we have already shown more

patience than the circumstances appear to justify. We must now require you to furnish us with replies to all outstanding enquiries and to let us know precisely within what time we may expect to receive outstanding reports and returns. We look to you to acknowledge the receipt of this letter without delay and to rectify the situation generally if our confidence is to be restored and we are to avoid the reconsideration of our arrangements in Manila.
