H. Dear Sirs,

<sup>ms</sup> I am in receipt of your cablegram respecting the ~~steamer~~ "STANVAC MEIFOO", and have to acquaint you that the Special Survey of this vessel's machinery was commenced at Hong Kong in April last by the examination of the following parts:-

Main engine cylinders, pistons and valves, and top ends, Crank and thrust shafts, Main engine circulating, lubricating oil, cargo, fire and bilge pumps, Nos. 1 2 & 3 generators and engines, Propeller and sea connections.

The Donkey Boiler Survey is overdue and on the occasion of the vessel being drydocked at Hong Kong last year it was recommended that pitting in all cargo tanks should be examined at the next drydocking.

I think it well to add that the Screwshaft Survey will become due at the end of next month.

Your attention is called to my communication of the 3rd November and your reply of the 20th December regarding this case.
