With further reference to my letter of the 24th March in connection with Glasgow First Entry Report No.238, it is concluded that the class to be assigned after satisfactory examination on arrival at Freetown should be +A- "Oil Tanker" "River and Estuary Service" with the descriptive notation "Swim Oil Barge", but confirmation on this point is desired.

I shall be glad if you will request the Surveyors to furnish the Breaking Test of the 2½" galvanised steel wire, and to confirm that the overall length is 121' 0".
