SHIP'S NAME "GOODWORKER" REPORT Sou. No. 21581

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

In May last a proposal to postpone the Special Survey until 2,53 was approved provided a satisfactory General Examination was held about the due date of the Special Survey (8,52).

In a letter dated 9.1.53 Owners advise that this ship is to work on contracts in the Persian Gulf in the vicinity of Kuwait. The Surveyors were advised accordingly.

The SOUTHAMPTON Surveyors report (2,53), this bucket dredger examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the requirements of a SPECIAL SURVEY (C) due 8,52 complied with.

On account of wear and tear repairs effected to shell and deck plating, etc. and minor items.

On account of damage, cause not stated, repairs effected to rider plate and minor items.

Minor alterations have been effected at this time with a view to ship's proposed towage to the Persian Gulf.

IT IS SUBMITTED the ship is eligible to remain as classed, with record of docking 1,53 and to have the Notation of 'ss.Sou.2,53' assigned.
