Dear Sir,

I am advised by the Owners of the "JAMES 46" and the dredger "GOOD WORKER" that these ships are to work ~~on contracts~~ in the Persian Gulf in the vicinity of Kuwait.

Both vessels are being prepared for towage to the Persian Gulf and Freeboard Certificates for the voyage out will be issued by the Ministry of Transport.

For your information I send a copy of a letter which has been addressed to the Southampton Surveyors regarding the classification, and I shall be glad if you will arrange for the necessary survey to be held on the ships' arrival.

The Load Line Certificates have not been issued by the Society to the "GOOD WORKER", but in the case of the "JAMES 46" I send herewith new service certificates for issue when the marks on the ship's side have been amended in accordance with the particulars inserted in the certificate, the freeboards verified, the classification survey referred to above held and in addition an Annual Load Line Survey held.

The Freeboard Certificates should be endorsed by you in respect of the Annual Survey before being handed over.
