ss "VASCO" and "CELTA".

Having received no acknowledgement from you of our letter of the 20th instant we have telegraphed that the steamer "CELTA" is now due Cardiff.

We now have to thank you for your telegram, <sup>advising</sup> that the Convention Freeboards for these vessels have not been assigned by Lloyd's Register and you assume the assignment has been made by Spanish Government Authorities. Further that if the latter consent you would be prepared to hold surveys on the two vessels.

We assume from this that it will be necessary for the Spanish Owner to put his case to the Spanish Government Authorities and obtain their consent in order that you are put in a position to hold surveys and make new assignments. Perhaps your confirmatory letter will throw a little further light on the matter and we are therefore not writing to the Owner until tomorrow.
