"SHELL 15" (Unclassed)

Mr. Hamilton of the Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. called at this Office today regarding the placing of this ship in service between Dakar and the Cape Verde Islands.

The ship is at present lying at Lisbon, and he was advised that the ship should be offered for classification and all the necessary repairs for this purpose carried out at Lisbon before the ship proceeded on a voyage to Dakar.

He stated that the ship was only capable of maintaining a speed of about 6 knots, and in these circumstances he was advised, for the voyage out, to have the ship towed.
