With further reference to my letter of the 3rd instant relating to the above vessel, I have to acquaint you that an "as fitted" plan of the electrical installation has now been received from the Society's Surveyors at Lisbon, together with a report on the installation as a whole. These documents

These documents have been examined, and I have to acquaint you that the electrical installation is such as could be accepted for classification, provided the main switchboard be wired with fuses on the "dead" side of the switches, correctly labelled and all connections fitted with locknuts; all flexible connections be re-wired with an earth continuity conductor and fitted with interlocking switch plugs; the secondary batteries re-housed in accordance with Rule requirements; and alternative supply and automatic indicators fitted to the navigation light circuits and a fuse provided on both poles of the compressor motor.
