With reference to your letters of 25th. & 28th. July we are advised by the Owners representative at this port that the present intention of the Company is to consider whether this vessel is suitable for classification & if so that they will then install new engines in the vessel; Consequently we enclose herewith only Reports Nos. 1, 8, & 13 as fitted & as drilled plans, on the understanding that you will make all the necessary recommendations to the Company's London office for their decision in the matter. Vessel has already a Load Line assignment from the Portuguese Authorities & the local office is of the opinion that it should remain thus in any case.

For your information with respect to fees, if desired to be charged at the present time, the work done at Lisbon has been equivalent to 4 surveyor-days (Total 4800 Esc.) with 50 Esc. expenses.
