The NAGASAKI Surveyors in a First Entry pt.1 and Rpt.8 report (11,64), ship examined in dry dock and float, scantlings and arrangements verified with the approved plans and the Special Survey for the Classification of Ships Not Built Under Survey carried out.

The equipment on board is equivalent to the requirements but tested by American Bureau Surveyors. It is submitted the equipment is acceptable for the Figure '1'.
