on the 6th July, 1963 and subsequently as she lay in drydock
at Piraeus and afloat at Perama for Damage Survey,

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of
Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by
me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am
recommending that she be continued as now classed without fresh
record of survey, subject to indented shell plating A1,2,3,4,5,
6,10,11, B6, (p.s.f.) and shell plates A1,3,4,5,6,11,12, B6,7
(s.s.f.) and fractured bent sternframe and rudder and bar keel
being dealt with before the vessel is recommissioned, also
subject to 1 bower anchor and 3 lengths of chain cable to Rule
size and requirements being supplied at the earliest opportunity
and remaining cables being examined.
