S. I duly received Mr. Thomas's letter of the 27th ultimo respecting the case of the Steam Tug "ST. BOTOLPH", and in reply have to acquaint you that a fee of £15. 15. 0 for the Hull and £5. 5. 0 for the Machinery was charged by the Glasgow Surveyors in connection with the alterations effected to the Tug "ST. ATHAN" at Irvine in November 1924-March 1925 whilst being converted for the burning of oil fuel.
