153548 "FRISTON DOWN". This ship has today been classed +A1 "Tug" "River Thames Service" together with the appropriate notations.

152751 "VICTOR ALLCARD". This ship has today been classed +A1 "Thames Estuary Service" together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

I shall be glad if you will forward a Report C11 in view of the fact that this is now required by the Committee whether or not freeboards are assigned.
