CLASSING LETTER

2589 "R.I. SORONG". This ship has today been classed \$100A1 "Oil Tanker" together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

With regard to the screwshaft liner I shall be glad if you will state whether it was fitted in two pieces and, if so, whether the joint complies with Instructions to Surveyors, Part 2b, Amendment No.2.

It is observed that the main engine crankcase relief devices are appreciably less than present Rule requirements, however, the construction of this engine was welladvanced before the Rule was modified. I would point out that in all future cases the new Rule should apply.
