Screwshaft Surveys for
Rea Towing Company's Tugs.

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant and have arranged for the Owners' request in this matter to receive consideration here.

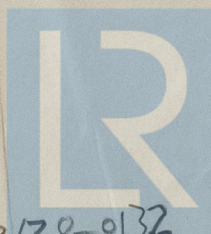
In reply, I would inform you that the Committee will be agreeable for surveys on screwshafts of this fleet which are fitted with continuous liners or approved oil glands to be held at four-yearly intervals on the understanding that these tugs are employed in river or dock service only.

This decision appears to apply to "APPIEGARTH" "AYSGARTH" "BANGARTH" "CEDARGARTH" "GRASSGARTH" "HAZELGARTH" "MAPLEGARTH" "ROSEGARTH" "THROSTLEGARTH" and "WILLOWGARTH"; but there is neither C.L. nor O.G. recorded in the cases of the "LANGARTH" and "KINGGARTH". In these latter instances therefore, Screwshaft Surveys will be reckoned as falling due at two-yearly intervals.
