You will have seen from the Technical Committee Prints which are sent you for information, that the Technical Committee recommended a new class of 100AL "Ore Carrier" assignable to ships which had complied with our additional requirements, the details of which were quoted.

The General Committee agreed these recommendations on the 21st ultimo and the usual official notice to that effect will be sent you shortly.

Meantime the tanker "EUROPE" was recently converted to an ore carrier at Kiel and renamed the "ADOUR".

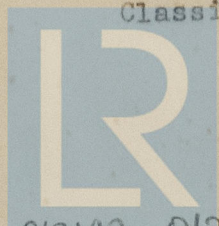
We find that the new Rules for this special class have been complied with so that if the Owner wishes we should be prepared to amend the class from 100AL "Carrying petroleum in bulk" to 100AL "Ore Carrier".

Will you please contact Messrs. K. Salvesen & Sonner and ask them whether they would like this new class, or whether they would prefer 100AL without, of course, the notation of "Carrying petroleum in bulk".
