Tanker "EUROPE" - No. 59539 in R.B.
Tanker "W.R. LUNDGREN" - No. 82252 in R.B.
Tanker "NIKE" - No. 71374 in R.B.

We learn from the Kiel Surveyors that the above three tankers are to be taken in hand by Messrs. Kieler Howaldtswerke for conversion to ore carriers, and we understand that the first of them, "EUROPE", is due to arrive in Kiel to-morrow, 30th instant.

We learn further, that Messrs. Arnesen, Christensen & Smith are interested in the project for the first vessel and that the matter has already been discussed in your Office.

We confirm our telephone conversation with Mr. J.M. Murray when Mr. Murray stated that the case of the "EUROPE" had in fact been dealt with in your Office and that plans and other particulars would be forwarded to us for our guidance in dealing with Messrs. Howaldtswerkes' plans.

As regards the other two vessels, "W.R. LUNDGREN" and "NIKE", we shall, as requested by Mr. Murray, forward the proposals to your Office as soon as these are received.
