We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the ~~Hull~~, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 53 building by Messrs. Adlex Skibsvaerksted og A.P. Møller for Messrs. A.P. Møller, Copenhagen about 7950 Tons. Length 465' Breadth 62', Depth 34'3 intended to be Classed +100 A/.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees of the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
