A Special Survey for Classification was commenced at Bremen 7.59 by examination of shell plating, sternframe, and rudder, also drilling of shell plating amidships with satisfactory results.

The ship then proceeded to Newcastle and the Surveyors there were advised of the items dealt with at Bremen.

ACTION is DEFERRED for completion of the Special Survey for Classification.

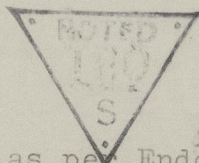
The Newcastle Surveyors in a F.E. Rpt., Rpt.8 and Rpt.8 (Dr.) report (10.59) ship examined afloat and in drydock, the Special Survey for Classification completed and a number of alterations and additions in connection with, ventilators, airpipes, scuppers and discharges etc., dealt with.

The anchors and chain cables are equivalent to Rule requirements and have been tested by Germanisher Lloyd.

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED they are acceptable for the Figure 1, but without Notation LACP.

IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the ship is now eligible to be classed 100 A1 "Oil Tanker" and to have Notations S.S. 10.59 and DS. 10.59 assigned.
