Messrs. Crichton Vulcan, Yard Nos. 1027/8.
Messrs. Maskin och Bro, Boilers Nos. 2705/6.

I duly received your letter of the 6th ultimo, with enclosures, in connection with the above, and in reply have to inform you that plan No. 200150/B of fusion welded vertical "Rapid" boiler will be approved for a working pressure of 8 Kgs./sq. cm., provided the shells be in accordance with the Rules for Welded Pressure Vessels, Class I, and the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

Four copies of the plan are returned herewith.

We would emphasize that these boilers cannot be accepted until such time as Messrs. Maskin och Bro's Works have received approval for the manufacture of Class I pressure vessels. In this connection, your attention is drawn to our letter of the 26th ultimo relating to the donkey boilers Nos. 2500/1 fitted in the Icebreaker "KAPITAN BELOUSOV", Sandvikens, Yard No. 354.
