I duly received your letter of the 15th instant, requesting copies of the Certificate covering the last Special Survey of the hull of the above vessel.

On looking into this I regret to say no Certificate was previously issued, so I am now enclosing an up-to-date Certificate to include the Docking Survey record of 1.62, following, the Survey carried out at Venice in January 1962.

With regard to the conditions of class at that time in respect of the sternframe and Main Engine portside column in way of H.P. cylinder, these items have been dealt with.

I would also refer you to subsequent correspondence and remind you that the Committee has agreed to the Special Survey and Engine Survey due in July 1962 being postponed until May next.

I regret that no reply was sent to your letter of the 8th January last and in this connection I have to say it is not our practice to issue Boiler Survey Certificates, but a note of the record of BLRS 11.62 will be shown on the Certificate which will be issued following the Engine Survey when that it is completed in May next.
