As a result of the survey carried out on this ship at Venice in January last, I have to inform you that the class has been continued subject, inter alia, to the temporary repairs to Main Engine port side column in way of the HP cylinder being specially examined by the end of this month. I shall be glad if you will let me know what arrangements can be made for this matter to receive attention.

At the sametime I would remind you that the Special Survey becomes due at the end of July, and the Owners' intentions regarding this inspection will also be appreciated. It is concluded that the Main Boiler Survey, also due at the end of July, will be carried out at the Special Survey but confirmation of this is desired.
