With reference to your classing letter of the 25th ultimo respecting the s.s. "BURMOUNT", I beg to inform you that the indented shell plating on the port side was stated to have been sustained through collision with the s.s. "UFFE" whilst leaving Antwerp on the 6th February, 1949, and on the starboard side by the vessel ranging alongside the quay at Bombay between the 28th May and the 1st June, 1949.

It is regretted that this information was not supplied in Report No. 5249.
