S.S. "ATHAMAS"

I beg to inform you that I have been advised by the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that in accordance with the Rules the above named vessel should be equipped with 270 fathoms of chain cable.

As this vessel is only equipped with 240 fathoms of chain cable, therefore, 30 fathoms of chain cable should be supplied at earliest opportunity.

It must be noted that the above 30 fathoms of chain cable are in addition to the 45 fathoms of worn chain cable which were recommended to be renewed during the Special Survey.

Furthermore, I have been advised that concerning the Machinery, the propeller should be renewed at the first opportunity.

Therefore, I enclose herewith amended Hull and Machinery Interim Certificates as requested by the Committee which cancels the previous certificates dated Alexandria, 4/7/58.
