WALVIS BAY WHALERS.

I duly received your letter of the 13th instant with enclosures, the contents of which have been noted and for which I am obliged.

The cases of the "KOS XII", "KOS 26" and "KOS 27" have received the consideration of the Committee and the following notations have been assigned, viz:

- "KOS XII" - Docking date 3,49 Walvis Bay with notations of A.S. 11,49 and Blr. S. 11,49.
- "KOS 26" - Docking date 2,50 C.Fm. with notations of A.S. 6,49, Blr. S. 10,49 and S. B. 2,50.
- "KOS 27" - Docking date 7,49 Walvis Bay with notations of A.S. 7,49 and Blr. S. 10,49.

In the case of the "KOS XII", before assigning the Special Survey notations with date of 11,49, I shall be glad if you will furnish confirmation from Dr. Johannsen that the full requirements of an IWC Survey have been complied with in this instance.

At the same time, I shall be glad if you will point out to him that all future similar surveys should be reported on the Society's Official Forms, i.e. Rpts 8 and/or 9 etc. and for his guidance I attach a sample report setting out the form and method required in reporting the various surveys on the hull. It would be well also clear to Dr. Johannsen that the usual IWC Survey reports should be furnished when applicable.
