I have been advised by the Society's Surveyor at New Orleans that the above vessels were sold on the 23rd March to the Commercial Metals Company of Dallas, Texas to be delivered to Beaumont, Texas for scrapping.

The terms and conditions of the sale in each case require that the buyer shall not use or operate the vessels as a means of transportation of passengers or cargo for hire, and that the hulls shall within 18 months after the date of delivery be completely scrapped.

The Surveyor at Galveston, Texas has been notified and I have asked him to advise you when the work of demolition is commenced.

The certificates for these vessels have been returned to this office and have been placed in the files.
