
(1) Starboard aft inboard double bollard broken across the base, at the root of the aft bollard of same.

As a new bollard was available, it was recommended that this be fitted.

(2) Hardwood pad in way of bollard badly cracked and broken.

Renew same.

The above repairs have been carried out to my satisfaction and can be considered permanent.
