Remarks In January the Aruba Surveyor forwarded a letter from the Owners intimating that this vessel is operating in bunkering service to large oil carriers within the confines of the Gulf of Paria, Eastern Venezuela, and would be replaced and laid up by March, 1955. In the circumstances, it was requested that the vessel's class might be maintained until that time. This proposal was agreed to by the Committee on the 1st February with the proviso that they could not agree to any further extension.

A further letter has been received from the Aruba Surveyor intimating that the Owners have informed him that the vessel is to be retired from service next month. It is the Owners' intention to send the vessel to Jacksonville to be laid up and, in the circumstances, it


