Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in February 1945

February 1950 Forward ballast tanks taken out of vessel
alterations consequent to this alteration 2-5" dia air pipes taken out of vessel.
Vessel converted to oil fuel

2-6" dia air pipes fitted to oil fuel deep tank 30" high ^{about 42} fitted with
gauge & hinged steel cover.

air pipes to settling tanks at sides of engine room fitted with gauge
Discharges one - 4" dia & one 2" dia discharge aft from 2nd deck.
fitted with screw down non return valves taken out of vessel & bolts
efficiently. ^{welded} filled by steel patches.

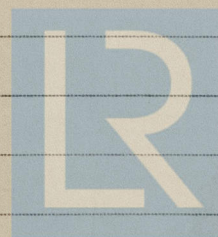
only shoot removed & opening in shell efficiently closed.
