that the thickness of the floors under the Boilers inside the
3/5 length is .40 and of the floors under Engines .34. The
keel angles fitted clear of the double bottom are $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times .34$
I regret that this was not clearly stated on the report.
