

recommended for the Special Survey:— Notation of S.S. with place and date where and when the survey will be completed.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. 36731 dated 2nd December, 1952

which is returned herewith.

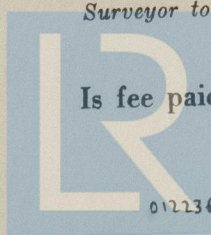
