This vessel was classed in June 1917, subject to the inner surface of the bottom plating, which is coated with tar and cement, being examined within six months from that time.

Action has been deferred in regard to this matter as the vessel was on Government Service.

The Owners now state the vessel is still under Government requisition, although they hope that she will be returned to them before long.

It is submitted action might be deferred for a short time.
