Surveyed the S.S. "HELLAS" ex. "TAROONA" 4326 tons gross of Piraeus whilst lying afloat & in the Govt. Graving Dock at Piraeus on the 10th December, 1959 & subsequently on account of Commencement of Special Survey, Docking Survey & Drilling Survey & Alterations,

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am continued as now classed in the Register

Recommending that she be Book with fresh record of D.S. 3,60 & to have the notation of S.S.(Dr.) 3,60, when the survey is completed, subject to indented shell plates J12, H12 & G7 and J15 & K14 (ss from fwd.) being dealt with as necessary, W.T. bulkhead 28 being stiffened & W.T. doors being tested, new deck beams inside No.3 hatchway trunk being dealt with, supports of boat deck extension being fitted, new sewage tank being dealt with, all by completion of special survey also subject to 15 fms. chain cable being supplied at earliest opportunity, but without condition of class regarding rivets in aft boundary angle of (p) settling tank.
